Dear Religious Education Family,

Enclosed is your 2018-2019 registration form for the traditional Religious Education program and/or the Confirmation preparation program (G 7 & 8.)

Registration Guidelines:

1. A registration form must be filled out for each child registered in the program. Update any information that you may have listed in previous years, especially the emergency contact. Please update your e-mail address, as this is how we communicate with all families. You can either mail the completed form to the Religious Education office or drop it off at the RE office.
2. The Religious Education Parent Contract and emergency contact list is enclosed in this packet, please read, sign and return it with your completed registration form.
3. **New students** to the program are to provide the Religious Education office with a copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate along with any other sacramental Certificates if they did not make these Sacraments at St. Benedict. If the child is coming from another Religious Education program or school, a letter of transfer from the former Religious Education program or Catholic school is required.
4. All families are required to be a registered member of the parish in order for your child/children to attend Religious Education at St. Benedict.
5. Home study is only an option for a student that is unable to attend classes due to a medical, academic and/or behavioral situation. Home study is not permitted for 2nd and 8th graders receiving a sacrament.

Religious Education Grades 1-6:

All classes will be held on Wednesday afternoons at 4:45-6:00 p.m. from September through May.

Confirmation Preparation Grades 7/8:

Grades 7 and 8 will be meeting on scheduled Sunday's from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. (Schedule to be released by June 30, 2018 – about 2 sessions per month)

Grade 8: Confirmation date is determined by the Diocese of Trenton; the date will be announced as soon as we receive it:

Attendance:

When you enroll your child in the Religious Education program, you must impress upon him/her the importance of his/her faith journey. Therefore, a child should be taught that all Religious Education classes are "priority over other activities."

Attendance at Mass is required of all students.

Children are encouraged to attend all class sessions. Three absences are accepted for Grades 1-6 and two absences for the Grade 7/8 program. Parents/guardians are required to call the Religious Education office when their child is absent. If there is a prolonged illness, a doctor's note is required. As for any absence, the child and parent are required to review the work covered in class. If a child exceeds the number of absences allowed the year may have to be repeated. An excused absence is only granted with a doctor's note.

Volunteer Form:

All families are encouraged to volunteer in our program. (Many hands make light work!) Please read through the volunteer job descriptions and decide on a position that you can fulfill.

- Tuition rebates are available to those who volunteer, please contact the Religious Education Office if you are interested.
- All volunteers are required to comply with The Safe Environment Policy that is mandated by the Diocese of Trenton. Information on the policy is available in the Parish Office and on the website under parent resources. <https://15175.sites.ecatholic.com/catechistvolunteer>

1. I will educate my child, along with St. Benedict Catholic Church in our Catholic Faith.
2. My child will attend Mass on Sunday and Religious Education classes regularly. The only excused absences will be those that are accompanied by a doctor's note. I understand that if my child has more than allowed absences without a doctor's note that there is a risk of repeating the school year.
3. I understand that Religious Education is an intellectual education as well as a spiritual experience.
4. Each week my child will be prepared for class with a notebook, text book, pencil or pen and a folder. If my child is in grade 6, 7 or 8, he or she will also be prepared with a Bible.
5. My 7th or 8th grade child will complete and document 20 hours of community service prior to Confirmation.
7. My child will treat teachers, classmates and the property of others respectfully at all times.

Volunteer Descriptions:

Catechist Grades 1-6: A catechist must be a practicing Catholic who participates in the liturgical life of the community and is open and willing to sharing the faith with others. Catechists are required to follow the curriculum provided by the Religious Education office and prepare weekly lessons for their assigned class. Catechists are required to continue their faith formation through the catechist certification process.

Summer Academy: Many hands are needed for this program to be successful. If you are able to give of your time as a classroom aide, hall monitor, craft helper, lunch/recess ideal please let us know.

Nurse: The Summer Academy requires a nurse on the premise. If you or you know someone that can help, please let us know.

Grade 7/8 Facilitator: A Facilitator must be a practicing Catholic who participates in the liturgical life of the community and is open and willing to sharing the faith with others. Facilitators are required to follow the curriculum provided by the Director of Religious Education. Training will be provided for all facilitators over the summer and throughout the year. Facilitators are required to continue their faith formation through the catechist certification process.

Classroom Aide Grades 1-6: Volunteers are needed to help the catechist with the class on a weekly basis. They will also be asked to be the substitute catechist in the event the catechist is not available.

Grade 7/8 Assistant Facilitator: Volunteers are needed to help the facilitator with the group discussion. They will be asked to fill in when the facilitator is not available.

Substitute Catechists/facilitators: Volunteers are needed to be substitutes for the classes when the catechist is absent. All necessary material will be provided.

Hall Monitors: Volunteers will be responsible for monitoring the traffic in the hallways and maintaining safety and order in the halls at all times. Hall monitors are needed from September through May.

Pre-School liturgy Catechists: Pre-School catechists are to be a practicing Catholic who is open and willing to share their faith with 4/5/6 year olds. This class meets on Sunday morning at 9:30 and 11:00 a.m. during the Liturgy of the Word. Children are brought back to their parents during the Eucharistic prayer.

General Office Help:

Volunteers are needed to help with copying and light office work.

All volunteers must follow the following procedure.

1. All volunteers that work directly with children on a consistent basis MUST complete a Virtus training session. For information on training sessions, visit www.virtusonline.com .
2. All volunteers must be fingerprinted according to the guidelines established by the Diocese of Trenton. Please obtain a form in the Parish Office.
3. All Volunteers must sign a Code of Conduct Form and a Volunteer Application, which is kept on file in the Parish Office.
